Book is old enough now (over a decade) that many of the companies reviewed or mentioned are not even in business any longer. Mr. Sweeney also has an "interesting" process for selecting pictures to go with his articles within the book (and his others, I went ahead and bought 'em all). Many of the features he describes as being exemplary are, frustratingly, not pictures, but multiple angles of him shooting the rifle are invariably included.
