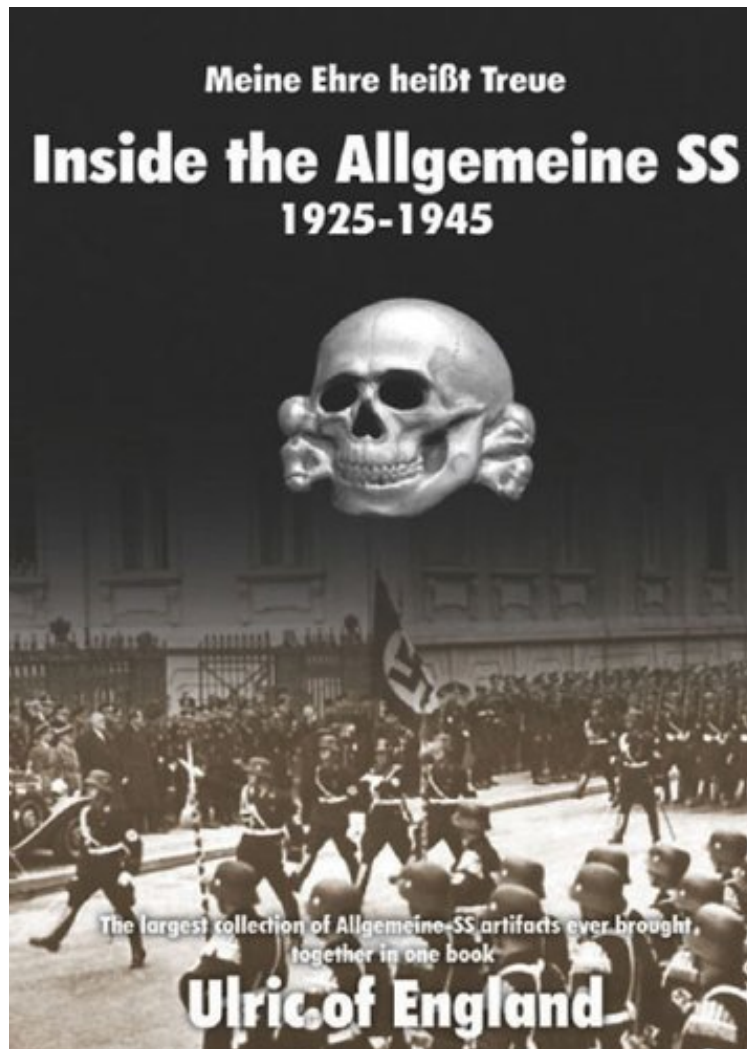

Ulric really did his homework on this offering. This is a very well produced book, solid binding, heavy pages, dust jacket and even a silk ribbon marker. There is an impressive mix of well chosen contemporary and vintage images and a thoughtfully laid out division of materials. The book is divided into two parts. The first part treats the philosophy, beliefs and culture of this military organization and the second showcases an impressive collection of its myriad artifacts. The overall work leaves one with a much greater understanding of the SS and its members. This book had to have taken an enormous

amount of time and research to produce. Today the Allgemeine-SS is equally enigmatic; as the vehicle by which Himmler proposed to implement his thesis to create a 'Center of the New World'; its structure, and psychology remains little-understood. Authored by leading militaria specialists Ulric of England, *Meine Ehre Heißt Treue* extends deep inside the Allgemeine-SS to reveal an unsurpassed creativity and philosophy.
